Annual Report 2021/22

Like all groups, Set in Their Ways (SITW) stopped meeting in Mid 2021 in line with the COVID-19 restrictions in place at the time.

SITW however resumed dancing in late 2021 and continued meeting Monday nights from February to June 2022.

The aim of SITW's is to provide advanced dancing opportunities in Irish Set Dancing (ISD) and to promote MFS and ISD through displaying and teaching at festivals and events. SITW was able to do the later part of this goal by being accepted as a performance group into the National Folk Festival (NFF). The groups finances are summarised below:

Both the income and expenditure are higher than the approved budget. This is due to the increase attendance in preparation of the NFF and the increase in Hall hire fees.
