Activities during FY 2017/2018:

Budget:

Basically we are cost neutral to the MFS. We don't charge for bookings and cover the cost of hall hire etc. via contributions from the dancers, who also all buy their own costumes. Practically at the beginning of each term we pre-pay for hall rental and end up with a deficit of a couple of hundred dollars that we could recoup by cancelling the booking, and at the end of each term we take the money from the tin we collect weekly subscriptions in that extinguishes the debt and may generate a small profit (\$50 say) that is then often spent on cake or a free evening for the dancers. So we do not represent either a financial liability or source of revenue for the Society. We are just a collection of members enjoying dancing.

Next year we would expect a similar schedule, or a more reduced series of activities as several members have been away on extended trips, including the main teachers. As a result, we have been applying for less performance gigs as adequate practise cannot be assured.
