Goals and Objectives:

This group meets to play collected Australian music.

Description of activity:

This group meets between 7.15 – 9.30 PM on the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays of each month except January, in the Grant Cameron Community Centre, 27 Mulley Street, Holder.

Over the past 12 months: On average about 5-6 people attend these meetings

All participants have been members of the MFS. This is an ongoing activity. It happens under an arrangement formed between the Monaro Folk Society and Arthritis ACT in 2015.

Under the arrangement Arthritis ACT book a meeting room in the Community Centre which we use to practice/play these tunes. In return the Monaro Folk Society has agreed to provide musicians to play for occasional dances and events organised by Arthritis ACT.

In August the Settlers participants provided music for a 'meet and greet' function hosted by Arthritis ACT at the Irish Club". Greg Wilson and Jackie lead this venture.

Arthritis ACT carries Public Liability for the rooms it provides and for the events it organises.
